The Year in Review

ECC Art Student Exhibition

The gallery featured an art exhibit of pieces from ECC Art Students, as well as Greg & Glenda Metzen during January, 2009. A reception was held on January 29, 2009.

6th Annual Visiting Artist Program

Missouri artist, John Preus, presented his work in the gallery and visited schools across Hardin County. John's work consisted of ceramics, sculpture, and photography. This year, the Visiting Artist program reached 268 students in elementary, middle school, high school, and college classrooms in Hardin County. This year's Visiting Artist Program was funded by membership dollars.

2009 Art Decko Gala

An evening of art, food, and music was held in conjunction with a silent auction. Approximately 115 attendees visited local homes where permanent pieces from the collection were displayed, then enjoyed an informal meal with music from the K & L duo at the Iowa Falls National Guard Armory. This event was sponsored by the Kruse Family Foundation and gala patrons.

4th of July Gallery Open House

The Carnegie-Ellsworth gallery was open to the public over the 4th of July holiday weekend.

Zack & Eddie Event

Zack Jones, painter, and Eddie Elliott, vocalist, provided entertainment at Highland Country Club in August. This event was well attended by PCAC members and golf club members.

Pre-Owned Art Sale

The PCAC held a pre-owned art sale on Saturday, October 24, on the patio of the Carnegie-Ellsworth building. This was held in conjunction with the Iowa Falls wine tasting event.

Christmas Reception

A holiday, nutcracker-themed reception was held at the gallery in December. Pat Clark, herself, was in attendance. Pat presented three new pieces to the collection. The newly framed posters from the permanent collection were on display.





PCAC Projects

CURRENT:

Art books donated to the college by Pat Clark were added to those available for viewing in the ECC library. The PCAC workshop student completed this project.

Local individuals and businesses adopted a total of 41 posters from the permanent collection. These posters, along with 30 funded by Hardin County Community Endowment Foundation, were framed, numbered, and labeled and are now ready for display.

A permanent storage location has been secured on the campus of Ellsworth Community College, Kruse-Main building. This location is being prepared and storage systems are being researched.

New gallery display panels were purchased from Armstrong Products, Inc. and installed in the gallery. This project was funded in part by Barlow Family Foundation.

FUTURE:

The new storage location in Kruse-Main on the ECC campus will continue to be upgraded, i.e., light-blocking window treatments, heat/air ventilation checked, roof checked for leaks, new locks/door. Once the room is prepared, shelving will be purchased and the art will be re-located.

Updates to the gallery are long-range goals, i.e., new roof to solve water issues, new coat of paint on walls, and new outer-wall hanging systems.

Grant and/or donor funding will be pursued for these projects.

Future Events:

A local student artist will have a gallery exhibit during January, 2010.

A local elementary art teacher will have a gallery exhibit during February, 2010.

The 7th annual Visiting Artist Program is scheduled for March, 2010.

The annual gala is slated for May 7, 2010.

Another evening of art and music will be slated for summer 2010.

The 2nd annual pre-owned art sale will be held in the fall of 2010.
