## **The Year in Review**

### ***January Reception***

“Visages” featuring permanent pieces from the Pat Clark Art Collection. A exhibition reception was held January 10, 2014. Pat Clark was in attendance for the event.

### ***11<sup>th</sup> Annual Visiting Artist Program***

Iowa artist, Ray “Bubba” Sorensen II presented his work in the gallery and visited schools across Hardin County. Ray “Bubba” paints the Freedom Rock each year in honor of veterans. He has also started a Freedom Rock tour and plans to paint rocks in all 99 counties in Iowa. This year, the Visiting Artist program reached 360 students in elementary, middle school, high school, and college classrooms in Hardin County. The gallery also featured an art exhibit of pieces from ECC Art Students, Brenda Cousins and Joel Frank. A reception was held on March 7, 2014. *This year’s Visiting Artist Program was funded by membership dollars and the Iowa Falls Community Chest Grant.*

### ***2014 Pat Clark Art Gala***

An evening of art, food, and music was held in conjunction with a silent and live auction. Approximately 100 attendees enjoyed hors d’oeuvres, meal, and entertainment at The Scenic City Empress Boat Club where permanent pieces from the collection were displayed. Music was provided by Ali Campbell and Haley Auston. Pat Clark, Carman Cunningham, and Virginia Daley were special guests at the event. Pat Clark introduced the new Pat Clark booklet, “Her World in Art”. The gala was held on May 9, 2014. *This event was sponsored by the Kruse Family Foundation and gala patrons.*

### ***Iowa Falls Art Walk***
